COLPAI Project – Removal of the tower crane over the weekend of Saturday 10 July – Sunday 11 July 2021

Dear Neighbour

We are writing to notify you of upcoming works at the COLPAI Project.

The removal of the site tower crane across the weekend of Saturday 3 July – Sunday 4 July 2021 was unable to be completed due to mechanical issues with the hired lifting equipment. The crane jib and ballast have both been removed, however further works are required to remove the mast section.

Therefore, works will be taking place to complete the removal of the tower crane across the weekend of Saturday 10 July – Sunday 11 July 2021. The works may take the full two days to complete and will require the closure of Golden Lane. ISG has arranged the necessary traffic management, and vehicle permits have been sought and obtained from the police authority prior to the works commencing.

We understand traffic management restrictions will begin from 6am on Saturday 10 July and will remain in place overnight on the Saturday. Large vehicles will have to be taken off the main highway and parked in the traffic management zone by 7am. We have investigated whether works could have been started on the Friday evening, however essential vehicles are not available until the Saturday.

ISG has contacted Islington and City of London Environmental departments to notify them of the upcoming works. Permission has been granted by both local authorities for the works to take place from 8am-6pm on Saturday 10 July 2021 and Sunday 11 July 2021.

While the works are being undertaken pedestrians will continue to have access to the path opposite the site on Golden Lane. We understand that there are other road closures in the wider surrounding area, but these are outside of the control of ISG.
