# Overview of the COLPAI Project Webinar and Summary of Questions Raised

### **Welcome and Introductions**

- Residential Building Painting works and areas ready for kitchen unit installation and External ductwork penetrations
- Residential Building Internal lift installation
- Residential Building External brickwork façade installation, Riser door access hatch and High level first fix mechanical and electrical installation

# Working hours and COVID-19 Guidelines

ISG noted that it is continuing to work within the guidelines. After Christmas and into the new year ISG will be working on the external finishes on all elevations.

ISG are selecting the Saturdays they work and are not working every Saturday. Monitoring has been removed, following completion of the school. However, further monitoring may be set up again once the external works start, which is not for several weeks.



ISG is taking advice from the Construction Leadership Council regarding COVID-19, which centres around wearing masks in the welfare areas and meeting rooms.

Additional welfare areas and hygiene areas have been installed. As well as this, ISG are managing the number of people in these areas at any one time

ISG are continuing to monitor the guidance as this develops and will develop their plans in line with this.

Working hours are: Monday-Friday: 8am-6pm Saturday: 9am-2pm

## **Christmas Closure Arrangements**

ISG will be finishing work on 23 December 2021 and will restart on 4 January 2022.

There will be out of hours security coverage through the logistics provider, who will attend to any alarm activation. As well as this, there is 24-hour monitored CCTV security cover.
