Works will be taking place on Saturday 17 June 2023, which are as follows:

- Brickwork
- Finalising workshop fronts
- Basement fire stopping works

- Snagging on brickwork and glass reinforced concrete.

Construction Activities

Upcoming works will reflect those undertaken on the previous week.

- Installation of precast concrete to external walls

- Works using external mobile elevated working platforms (MEWPs)

- Scaffold adaptions.

Note On Upcoming Landscape Works From July 2023

Please be aware that starting Monday 3 July 2023, we will resume external landscaping activities. Before that date, we will be removing materials from the rear of the building to prepare for these works. These works are expected to continue for four weeks.

The primary emphasis of the landscaping efforts will involve tarmac, which means the use of plant equipment. Heras fencing will be installed as the current hoarding is removed. Furthermore, we will install seating and paving, while also completing the soft-landscaped areas surrounding the building.
